CONFERENCE SPEAKERS



Jim Rascati, LCSW, is a specialist in first-responder trauma and a clinical instructor (social work) in psychiatry for Yale School of Medicine. Following the Sandy Hook shooting, he led the critical incident stress debriefing sessions for the Newtown Police Department and is recognized nationally as an authority on mass-casualty trauma .



Tabatha Maiorano, PhD, is a Licensed Clinical Social Worker/Public Safety Specialist (Specializing in Mental Health, Criminal Justice, and Human Behavior). She is founder and principal of TD Forensics, LLC, offering state-of-the-art trauma treatment for first responders.



Rev. **John Revell** serves as chaplain for the Connecticut State Police and multiple first responder agencies across the state. He is a certified instructor in emotional and spiritual wellness for Connecticut’s “Police Officer Standardized Training Council” (POST), and has instructed widely on the impact of Moral Injury upon first responders.



George Faller is a former NYPD officer and FDNY firefighter. Following 9/11, he turned his attention to family counseling, initially with first responders and their families. He is a highly-sought-after conference speaker both in the United States and around the world.
